WELCOME TO CELTIC PARK

Today we extend a warm welcome to newly promoted Trethomas Bluebirds for a 1st round MG Nathaniel Cup tie. The Bluebirds are making their debut in this competition having been promoted to the Cymru South as last season's champions from the Ardal South-East League.

The Bluebirds playing squad noted in today's programme shows that over the past 12 months they have spent heavily on bringing in several experienced journeymen including former Celtic midfielder James Young.

Cwmbran Celtic has never been able to match the big spenders and this has led in recent seasons to the club losing the services of high-flyers such as Academy-produced strikers Chris Ham and Josh Bull. During the close season we lost Lewis Iles (to Llanelli) and Harrison Lewis (to Ammanford). We wish them the very best at their new clubs.

Last season the club lost its Academy in a pre-determined axe-wielding by the FAW to reduce numbers which left Gwent without a single Academy and yet preserved an underperforming Academy intact at English-based Merthyr Town who, to add insult, recruited our entire U18 squad. Fortunately, our 2023 Torfaen U16s stepped up to the plate in our FAW Youth League side and half a dozen have already appeared in the 1st team.

Our new manager Simon Berry welcomes back to the club midfielder Isaac Powell (from Hereford Lads) and returning central defender Jordan Meaney together with other newcomers to Simon's initial 1st team squad - striker Jude Bull (from Blaenavon - brother of Josh), former Celtic Academy keeper Jamie Pring (from Caerleon), and midfielder Tan Jones from Merthyr. Also available will be midfielder Mario Van Dieren who was signed after last season's deadline and consequently played out the season in the Reserves.

CELTIC REGAIN TUCKER MEMORIAL TROPHY

Cwmbran Celtic re-gained the Tucker Memorial Trophy in the annual fixture against Croesyceiliog in memory of former manager of both clubs, Terry 'Tucker' Cunningham, with an emphatic 9-3 win at Celtic Park. The game was a good work-out for both sides who were each able to field different teams in each half. Celtic's scorers were 17-year-olds Gabriel Howells 4 and Jude Bull 2, and Cymru South Golden Boot winner Alex Bonthron 3. Celtic now lead 2-1 in the series which started in 2022.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF TRETHOMAS BLUEBIRDS

Formed in 1903 as Trethomas Football Club, the pitch was bought by the miners who worked at the mines of Trethomas. According to local accounts, workers at the Bedwas Colliery purchased land in the nearby village of Trethomas – called the Llanbafon Drive Playing Field, as a field for recreation, including organised sport. Legend has it, the Llanfabon Drive Playing Field served as the home of the Trethomas Bluebirds for more than 100 years.

Taking inspiration from Cardiff City, one of our founders then dubbed the club The Trethomas Bluebirds. The club entered the Gwent County League in 2003 and won promotion to Division Two as Champions in 2005-2006. Promotion to Division One followed and the club finished as runners up in the 2012/13 season. The club was then promoted to the Welsh Football League in 2015/16 for the first time.

OUR MISSION

Our number one goal for the upcoming season is to be promoted into the Cymru South League. We believe that our recent success and exciting signings have put us in the best position possible to win the league and gain promotion.

As a club, we are on a mission to provide an inclusive and supportive football community, whilst striving for excellence both on and off the pitch. As a team, we hold ourselves to the highest standards and always represent our club's values with integrity.




